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Hotel Drop-off

Stop 1: Swayambhunath Stupa (The Monkey Temple)

Recommended Time: 09:30 AM – 10:30 AM

Location: Western Hilltop, Kathmandu

Start your morning early atop a hill on the western rim of the Kathmandu Valley. Swayambhunath is one of the oldest and most revered Buddhist shrines in Nepal, dating back over 2,000 years. As the morning mist lifts, the panoramic vista of the expanding Kathmandu city unfolds below.

What to See & Experience

- **The 365 Steps:** Climb the steep, stone-paved staircase lined with statues and small shrines. Alternatively, your private vehicle from Attractive Travels and Tours can drop you at the rear entrance if you prefer to avoid the steep ascent.
- **The All-Seeing Eyes:** The central white dome is crowned by a gilded spire painted with the watchful eyes of the Buddha, representing wisdom and compassion.
- **Resident Macaques:** True to its nickname, hundreds of rhesus macaques roam the temple grounds, considered sacred in local tradition. Keep snacks and loose belongings secured!

Stop 2: Kathmandu Durbar Square (Hanuman Dhoka)

Recommended Time: 11:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Location: City Center, Old Kathmandu

Descend from Swayambhunath into the historical core of Kathmandu. Kathmandu Durbar Square is an architectural masterwork showcasing the heights of Newari craftsmanship achieved during the Malla dynasty (12th to 18th centuries).

What to See & Experience

- **Kumari Ghar (Palace of the Living Goddess):** Enter the intricately carved wooden courtyard of the Kumari Ghar. If fortunate, you may catch a quiet glance of the Living Goddess at her window.
- **Hanuman Dhoka Royal Palace:** Named after the stone deity of Hanuman guarding the main entrance, this expansive complex served as the royal residence for centuries.
- **Kal Bhairav:** Pay respects at the imposing, colorful open-air stone relief of Kal Bhairav—the fierce manifestation of Lord Shiva.
- **Taleju Temple & Kasthamandap:** Admire the multi-tiered pagoda structures and witness local daily worship.

Cultural Culinary Interlude: Lunching in Kathmandu

Recommended Time: 12:00 PM – 01:00 PM

No travel experience is complete without immersing yourself in local culinary traditions. During your midday break, sample authentic local fare at a recommended restaurant:

- **Dal Bhat Power:** The classic Nepali staple comprising steamed rice, aromatic lentil soup,

seasonal vegetable curry (tarkari), pickles (achar), and crisp papadams.

- **Momo Delights:** Steamed or fried dumplings filled with minced chicken, buff, or spiced vegetables, paired with a tangy sesame-tomato chutney.
- **Newari Khaja Set:** A traditional platter featuring beaten rice (chiura), spiced soybeans, marinated meats, spiced potato salad, and fresh ginger.

Stop 3: Pashupatinath Temple (The Sacred Hindu Sanctuary)

Recommended Time: 01:30 PM – 02:30 PM

Location: Banks of the Bagmati River

After lunch, travel east to Pashupatinath, the most sacred Hindu temple complex in Nepal, dedicated to Lord Shiva in his form as the Lord of All Creatures. Situated on the banks of the Bagmati River, Pashupatinath offers a profound, solemn look into life, death, and Hindu spiritual cycles.

What to See & Experience

- **Main Pagoda Temple:** While the inner sanctum is reserved for practicing Hindus, visitors enjoy unobstructed views of the double-roofed golden pagoda and the giant bronze statue of Nandi the Bull from across the river terrace.
- **Sacred Cremation Ghats (Aryaghat):** Observe open-air funeral pyres along the Bagmati River, where families gather for open traditional Hindu final rites.
- **Sadhus & Shrines:** Encounter holy men (Sadhus) painted in ash and draped in saffron robes, and explore the rows of small stone Shiva lingam shrines along the eastern bank terrace.

Stop 4: Boudhanath Stupa (The Realm of Tibetan Buddhism)

Recommended Time: 03:00 PM – 04:00 PM



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Location: Boudha, Northeastern Kathmandu

Conclude your day tour at Boudhanath, one of the largest spherical stupas in the world and the beating heart of Nepal's Tibetan Buddhist community. Mandala Base with Prayer Wheels.

What to See & Experience

- **The Kora Ritual:** Join locals, pilgrims, and crimson-robed monks in walking clockwise around the massive white mandala base while spinning copper prayer wheels and chanting Om Mani Padme Hum.
- **Monasteries (Gompas):** Step inside surrounding monasteries such as Guru Lhakhang Gumpa to admire giant statues of Padma Sambhava and intricate butter sculptures.
- **Rooftop 360 View of city and hills Experience:** Cap off your day at a rooftop cafe surrounding the stupa circle. Watch the beautiful view of city and hills include some Himalayas.

Alternative Day Tour Extensions & Customized Itineraries

If you have additional days or specific travel preferences, Attractive Travels and Tours offers customizable variations throughout the Kathmandu Valley:

Option A: The Medieval Arts Tour (Patan & Bhaktapur)

Patan Durbar Square: Famous for its Patan Museum, the stunning Krishna Mandir built entirely of carved stone, and the Golden Temple (Hiranya Varna Mahavihar).

Bhaktapur Durbar Square: A remarkably preserved vehicle-free medieval city known for the 55-Window Palace, the soaring five-tiered Nyatapola Temple, Pottery Square, and delicious Juju Dhau ("King Yogurt").

Option B: Mountain Sunrise & Nature Hike (Nagarkot to Changu Narayan)

Nagarkot Sunrise: Drive up early to [Nagarkot](#) (2,165m) for panoramic Himalayan vistas

extending from the Langtang range toward Mount Everest on clear mornings.

Changu Narayan Hike: Embark on a gentle 2-3-hour ridge hike down through pine forests and Newari villages to Changu Narayan, the oldest standing Hindu temple complex in the Kathmandu Valley.

Option C: Chandragiri Hills & Panoramic Cable Car

Take a scenic 2.5-kilometer cable car ride up [Chandragiri Hill](#) (2,551m) for sweeping aerial views of the entire Kathmandu Valley floor backed by the snow-capped Himalayan range.

Travel Tips for Your Kathmandu Day Tour

To ensure a smooth day, keep these essential travel tips in mind:

- **Dress Respectfully:** When visiting active religious sites like Pashupatinath, Swayambhunath, and Boudhanath, cover your shoulders and knees. Remove shoes and leather items before entering main temple inner sanctuaries.
- **Footwear:** Wear comfortable, slip-on walking shoes. You will be stepping on stone paved paths, climbing temple steps, and removing shoes frequently.
- **Photography Etiquette:** Always ask before photographing sadhus, monks, or local devotees. Photography is strictly prohibited inside certain temple interiors and at cremation grounds.
- **Hydration & Protection:** Carry a reusable water bottle, wide-brim hat, sunscreen, and dust masks during road transits.
- **Cash Payments:** While major hotels and upscale shops accept credit cards, keep Nepalese Rupees (NPR) on hand for site entry tickets, small handicraft purchases, and street snacks.
