

Bhutan Tour – 5 Days

You will develop a keen understanding of this nation, its culture, traditions, and religion through your Bhutan Cultural Tour. The tour takes you along scenic landscapes, from magnificent mountain ranges to lush green valleys. Bhutan is a beautiful country with stunning landscapes and many historical monuments.

The country lies in the eastern Himalayas, between Tibet and India, with Sikkim to its west. This trip covers Bhutan's two most popular tourist destinations: Thimphu, the capital city of Bhutan, and Paro, Bhutan's international airport, supplemented by a hike to [Taktsang](#) monastery.

A visit to these two places will give you a sound knowledge of Bhutan's rich culture and traditions. Accordingly, you can also witness the historical arts and crafts and the Bhutanese people's lifestyle.

The way of life, culture, and social design is striking components of the nation, which consistently draws in many visitors from across the globe. The Dzong architecture incorporated into the kingdom speaks beyond the bounds of Bhutanese Heritage. Allegedly, The dzongs worked during the 17th century, especially without using a single nail! These are the showstoppers among all Bhutanese designs.

Moreover, a short visit to Thimphu will lead you to the Heritage Museum and Tradition School of Arts and Crafts. Punakha National Park and Jigme Dorji National Library are some other sites included in the Bhutan Cultural Tour package.

Additionally, You will have the opportunity to visit some farmhouses and interact with the locals, particularly experiencing rural life. This cultural heritage proudly manifests itself and extends a unique artistic perspective— from the traditional woven garments to the prayer flags on high mountain slopes, the natural environment, and the religious, masked folk dances. You will enjoy the stunning views of the Himalayas from DochuLa Pass (3100 m) on the Bhutan Cultural Tour.

DochuLa Pass is one of Bhutan's most beautiful mountain passes, located about 20 km from Thimphu. During this time, you will also be able to witness the 108 memorial Stupas, also known as "Druk Wangyal Chortens."

In the Capital city of Paro, you will visit the famous [Taktsang](#) (Tiger's Nest Monastery), Ringpung Dzong (fortress), Kichu Lhakhang, and Drugyal Dzong. In the next destination at Thimphu, you will explore the memorial Chorten, nunnery temples, folk heritage museum, and

many other local attractions.

Finally, we'll drive to Punakha and visit the majestic Punakha Dzong. We are also visiting [Chimi Lhakhang](#), a famous Bhutanese fertility temple. As we move past the Dochula pass, you can enjoy the company of the unique Bhutanese landscape.

The best time to go on the Bhutan Cultural Tour is during the spring months of March-May when the valleys come alive with flowers in bloom, and in October for trekking—as the Himalayan peaks are prominently visible with clear skies.
