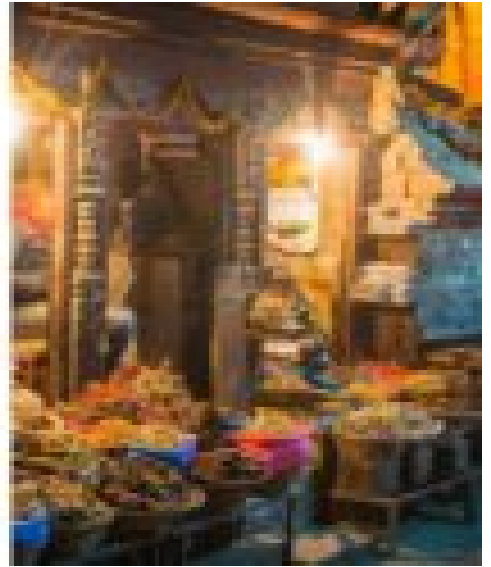
Key highlights include the Krishna Temple. **Additionally**, the Patan Museum houses an extensive collection of traditional metalwork and religious artifacts.

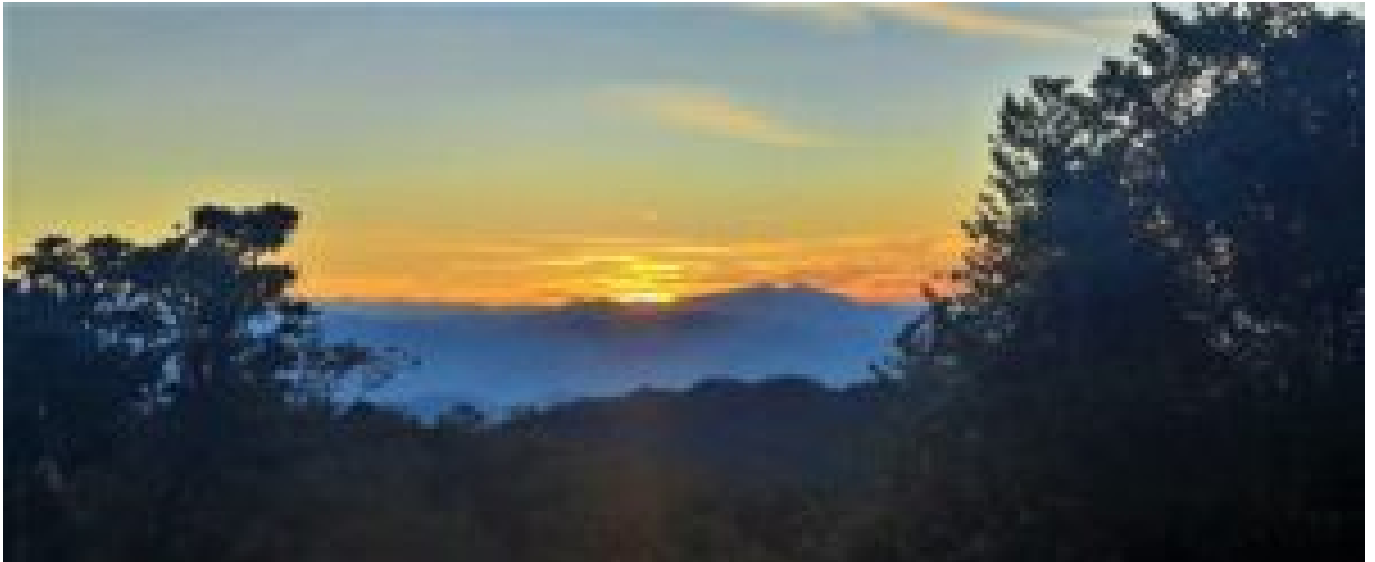
9. Chandragiri Hills: Panoramic Cable Car Rides
