Day 1: Kathmandu Valley UNESCO Sites Day Tour

Begin your Nepalese journey seamlessly with a warm welcome and an immersive cultural tour exploring the major spiritual and architectural landmarks of the Kathmandu Valley.

Your experience starts upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, where our representative will greet you and provide a private transfer. Head straight toward the sacred **Pashupatinath Temple**, situated on the banks of the holy Bagmati River. As one of the most revered Hindu shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva, it draws over a million devotees annually, particularly during the grand festival of Maha Shivaratri.

Next, proceed to **Boudhanath Stupa**, Nepal's largest spherical stupa steeped in Newar chronicles and deeply influenced by Tibetan culture, surrounded by numerous active monasteries. Afterward, head to **Swayambhunath Temple** (popularly known as the Monkey



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Temple). Climb the historic hilltop stone staircases accompanied by playful resident monkeys to reach the main stupa, and explore the surrounding shrines, a Tibetan monastery, a library, and a museum detailing the site's rich history.

Conclude your first day at **Patan Durbar Square** in the heart of Lalitpur, a masterpiece of Newari architecture that reached its artistic peak under the Malla kings. Marvel at key architectural highlights including the Krishna Temple, Patan Museum, Golden Temple, and Sundari Chowk, before concluding with a comfortable private drive back to your hotel.
