Panoramic Himalayan Vistas from Nagarkot

During the **Nagarkot and Bhaktapur Tour**, guests gather at the hilltop view tower to watch the morning sun light up the snow-capped peaks. **Remarkably**, eight of Nepal's thirteen Himalayan ranges—including Everest, Annapurna, Manaslu, Langtang, and Jugal—are visible on clear days. **Furthermore**, sweeping views across the green Kathmandu Valley and Shivapuri National Park make this an unforgettable natural retreat.

Discovering Medieval Art in Bhaktapur Durbar Square

After taking in the mountain panoramas, the tour moves to Bhaktapur Durbar Square, a living museum of Newari art and architecture. **Here**, timeless wood carvings, gilded gates, and ancient stone monoliths line the brick-paved plazas. **For instance**, you will explore the famous 55-Window Palace, towering pagoda shrines, and centuries-old artisan workshops where local potters still practice their craft today.

Day 1: Nagarkot and Bhaktapur Durbar Square UNESCO Tour

Experience a magnificent blend of Himalayan mountain panoramas and medieval Newari heritage on this full-day excursion from Kathmandu to the hill station of Nagarkot and the historic city of Bhaktapur.

Your journey begins before dawn with a 4:30 AM hotel pickup in Kathmandu for a private drive about 36 kilometers east to Nagarkot. Perched at an elevation of 2,175 meters, Nagarkot is celebrated as one of the region's finest vantage points. From the hilltop observation tower, you can witness a breathtaking sunrise illuminate multiple major Himalayan ranges—including Annapurna, Manaslu, Langtang, Rolwaling, and Mahalangur (Everest)—alongside sweeping views of the Kathmandu Valley and Shivapuri National Park.

After soaking in the mountain views and enjoying breakfast, you will head down to explore the timeless streets of Bhaktapur. Step back in time within Bhaktapur Durbar Square, a masterpiece of ancient Nepalese art, architecture, and pagoda-style temples. Wander through historic courtyards to discover cultural showpieces such as the 55-Window Palace, the intricate Golden Gate, the National Art Gallery, the towering Nyatapola Temple, and the vibrant Pottery Square.

Detailed Timetable

- **4:30 AM:** Early morning hotel pickup in Kathmandu and private drive to Nagarkot.
- **Sunrise:** Arrive at the ridge to view the sunrise over the high Himalayas.
- **Morning:** Enjoy breakfast with panoramic valley views, followed by a scenic transfer



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down to Bhaktapur.

- **Late Morning & Afternoon:** Explore the temples, palaces, and wood-carved monuments of Bhaktapur Durbar Square.
- **Evening:** Return transfer back to your hotel in Kathmandu.
