The enormous statue of the Gautam Buddha in Nepal sits on a pedestal. It is located on the western limit of Swayambhunath Temple, also known as the monkey temple. Behind the hill is a temple of Manjusri or Saraswati – the Goddess of learning. Shrines, statues, and holy places of Buddhist and Hindu divinities fill the stupa complex. Kathmandu Durbar Square, also known as Hanuman Dhoka Square, is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites. The name Hanuman Dhoka Durbar originated from the statue of Hanuman established by King Pratap Malla. It is at the entrance of the regal royal residence in 1672 A.D.

Several temples, shrines, courtyards, and a palace inside Durbar square exhibit the art and architecture of the medieval era. Boudhanath Stupa, located 8 km east of Kathmandu, stands out amongst the most monumental tourist spots in Kathmandu. The stupa of Boudhanath is

36-meter-high, making it one of the biggest stupas in South Asia. With infinite religious communities surrounding it, Boudhanath is Nepal's focal point of Tibetan and Nepalese Buddhism. Pashupatinath Temple is one of the four most significant religious sites in Asia for devotees. It was built in the fifth century and later Malla rulers redesigned it. The site itself is said to have existed from the thousand years when a Shiva lingam was found here. However, the most significant temple extends on the two sides of the Bagmati River.
