POKHARA TOUR

Numerous deer species, such as the Spotted, Barking Sambar, and Hog Deer, are also visible. With an outstanding variety of flora and wildlife, more than 450 kinds of birds are to be encountered.



Frequently Asked Question

Q: What time of year is ideal for Pokhara?

Pokhara is best visited in March, April, May, September, October, and November. The tourism center for the Manang, Mustang, and Annapurna regions in Pokhara. The city typically experiences cool temperatures during these months.

Q: What time of year is ideal for Kathmandu?

The most significant time to travel to Nepal is from October to December when the weather and the landscapes are breathtaking.

Throughout the year, the weather is dry and the temperatures vary from place to place. An average temperature of 6°C at Namche Bazaar in January and February can get freezing, particularly at night.

Q: How far is it to travel to Chitwan from Pokhara?

It is 151 kilometers to drive from Pokhara to the Chitwan District. From Pokhara to Chitwan District, the travel takes about 2 hours and 17 minutes.

Q: From Chitwan to Kathmandu, how far is it?

The travel time by land from Kathmandu to the Chitwan National Park only takes around five hours on a good day.

It's a beautiful journey that follows the Trisuli Valley, with its steep hills covered with woodland and farming communities, before turning south at Mugling and heading into the plains.
