Kathmandu



Your trip begins in Kathmandu. Here, you will explore world heritage sites and sacred religious shrines. Specifically, you will visit Kathmandu Durbar Square, Swayambhunath Stupa, Pashupatinath Temple, and Bouddhanath Stupa. Furthermore, our professional tour guide assists you at these places. Chitwan



Next, the tour takes you to Chitwan National Park. Established in 1973, it is the first national park in Nepal. Furthermore, UNESCO listed it as a World Heritage Site in 1984. Over 43 species of mammals thrive inside this park. Moreover, the park is especially renowned for protecting the endangered One-horned Rhino, Royal Bengal Tiger, and Gharial.

You will also observe the cultural dance of the Tharu people and their unique lifestyles. Additionally, your local guide leads you during jungle walks, bird watching, elephant back riding, canoeing, and village tours.

Lumbini



The journey also takes you to Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha. This sacred Buddhist pilgrimage site sits in the Rupandehi district. Queen Maya Devi gave birth to Siddhartha Gautama here in 623 BC. Every year, more than 400,000 pilgrims visit Lumbini. Because UNESCO recognizes it as a World Heritage Site, it holds immense archaeological importance. Ultimately, this is a place you must visit at least once in your life.

Pokhara



Finally, you will visit the beautiful city of Pokhara, which is the second biggest city in Nepal. Here, you will explore Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, Devi's Fall, a Tibetan refugee camp, and the International Mountaineering Museum. Furthermore, boating on Fewa Lake, visiting Barahi Temple, and hiking to the World Peace Stupa serve as prime highlights of your trip.

Frequently Asked Questions Kathmandu Chitwan Lumbini Pokhara Tour

What is the best time of year to take this tour?

The ideal seasons for this trip are **Spring (March to May)** and **Autumn (September to November)**. During these months, the weather remains pleasantly mild, skies stay clear, and mountain visibility is at its absolute best.

How strenuous is this travel itinerary?

This is primarily a **cultural sightseeing and leisure tour**, meaning it requires no strenuous trekking. Most daily activities involve easy city walking, guided monument visits, and comfortable vehicle transfers, making it suitable for travelers of all ages.

Is a visa required to enter Nepal, and can I obtain it on arrival?

Yes, most international travelers require a tourist visa for Nepal. Fortunately, you can easily obtain your visa **on arrival** at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu by filling out an application form and paying the fee in cash.

What kind of clothing should I pack for Kathmandu Chitwan Lumbini Pokhara?

We recommend packing lightweight, breathable clothing for daytime travel. However, because you will visit sacred temples and monasteries, modest clothing covering your shoulders and knees is necessary. Furthermore, pack a light jacket for cooler evenings, and neutral-colored clothing for the Chitwan jungle safari.

Are meals included during the city stays?

Breakfast is fully included during your hotel stays in Kathmandu, Pokhara, and Lumbini. However, lunches and dinners in these cities are excluded so you can explore local restaurants and taste authentic Nepali cuisine at your own pace.

What wildlife can I expect to see in Chitwan National Park?

Chitwan National Park protects numerous endangered species. While exploring the reserve, your expert guide helps you spot the One-horned Rhinoceros, wild elephants, spotted deer, marsh mugger crocodiles, and—with a bit of luck—the majestic Royal Bengal Tiger.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

We are delighted to welcome you to Nepal! Upon your arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, our friendly company representative and private driver will greet you warmly with a traditional welcome. They will assist you with your luggage and escort you in a private vehicle to your hotel in the city center. After check-in, you can rest from your journey or take a relaxed evening stroll around the vibrant streets of Thamel.

Day 2: Kathmandu Cultural Heritage & Spiritual Sightseeing

Immerse yourself in the rich history and deep spirituality of the Kathmandu Valley today. Accompanied by your expert private guide, you will explore four magnificent UNESCO World Heritage Sites:

- Kathmandu Durbar Square: Wander through ancient palace courtyards that showcase the exquisite wood carvings, courtyards, and architecture revealing the lifestyle of Nepal's former royals.
- Pashupatinath Temple: Visit one of the most sacred Hindu pilgrimage sites in the world,

situated along the holy Bagmati River, to witness traditional rituals and architectural grandeur.

- Swayambhunath Stupa (The Monkey Temple): Climb the hilltop steps to discover this ancient stupa adorned with the all-seeing eyes of the Buddha, offering panoramic views across the entire Kathmandu Valley.
- Boudhanath Stupa: Conclude your day at one of the largest spherical stupas in the world, where you can join Tibetan pilgrims in walking the sacred *kora* circuit amidst fluttering prayer flags.

Day 3: Exploring the Ancient Arts of Patan and Bhaktapur

Today, your cultural exploration continues as you discover two more magnificent, art-filled kingdoms within the Kathmandu Valley—Patan and Bhaktapur. Both cities are proud UNESCO World Heritage Sites celebrated for their extraordinary preserved architecture, ancient courtyards, and divine stone and wood idols.

- Patan Durbar Square: Often called the city of fine arts, Patan showcases master craftsmanship at every turn. You will admire the intricate palace courtyards and visit the iconic 17th-century Krishna Mandir, a stunning stone temple built by carving a single rock, dedicated to Lord Krishna.
- Bhaktapur Durbar Square: Step back in time as you wander through this remarkably preserved traditional medieval city. Here, you will explore majestic landmarks including the towering Nyatapole Temple, the ornate Golden Gate, the 55 Window Palace, the National Art Gallery, and the sacred Bhairavnath and Dattatreya temples, all reflecting a deeply rooted and unique local lifestyle.

Day 4: Scenic Overland Journey from Kathmandu to Pokhara

After a hearty breakfast this morning, you will depart Kathmandu and embark on a scenic 6-hour overland drive westward toward the stunning lakeside city of Pokhara. As your private vehicle winds along the highway, you will enjoy wonderful views of the rushing Trishuli River, lush green hills, terraced farmlands, and charming roadside villages. You will stop for a relaxing lunch along the way. Upon your arrival in Pokhara, the majestic Annapurna mountain range will greet you like a giant wall of snow-capped peaks. In the late afternoon, you can enjoy a peaceful boat ride on Phewa Lake and take a leisurely stroll through the vibrant streets of the lakeside market.

Day 5: Sunrise at Sarangkot & Pokhara Sightseeing Landmarks

Your day begins bright and early with a scenic drive to Sarangkot hill to witness an unforgettable sunrise over the Himalayas. From this panoramic vantage point, you will watch the



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first rays of sunlight gently kiss the snow-capped summits of the Annapurna and Dhaulagiri ranges to the north, while looking down over the peaceful Pokhara valley to the south.

After returning to the city for breakfast, you will explore the rich cultural and natural landmarks of Pokhara:

- Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave (Shiva Cave) & Davis Falls: Discover the mysterious underground waterfall where the Pardi Khola river plunges into a subterranean cavern, alongside the sacred underground Shiva cave shrine.
- Mahendra Cave: Explore this fascinating limestone cave filled with remarkable stalactite and stalagmite formations.
- Bindhyabashini Temple: Visit one of the oldest and most revered Hindu temples in Pokhara, dedicated to Goddess Bhagwati.
- International Mountain Museum (IMM): Gain deep insight into Himalayan mountaineering history, local mountain communities, and legendary climbing expeditions.
- World Peace Pagoda (Shanti Stupa): Conclude your afternoon by crossing Phewa Lake to visit this gleaming white Buddhist stupa, which offers a breathtaking, panoramic spectacle of the entire city and surrounding lakes.

Day 6: Journey from Pokhara to Chitwan National Park

After enjoying a pleasant breakfast this morning, you will depart Pokhara and travel southeast toward the subtropical lowlands of Chitwan. Upon your arrival at the jungle resort, our friendly



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Lodge staff will greet you with a refreshing welcome drink and provide a helpful briefing about your exciting afternoon jungle activities.

Following a delicious lunch, you will take a guided walking tour to a traditional Tharu village. Here, you will experience the unique culture, traditions, and self-sufficient lifestyle of the indigenous Tharu people who have inhabited the Terai region for generations. Afterward, you can relax and unwind at the edge of Chitwan National Park, Nepal's premier wildlife reserve covering 932 square kilometers of rich subtropical forest and grassland.

Day 7: Full-Day Wildlife Safari Adventures in Chitwan National Park

Immerse yourself fully in the natural wonders of Chitwan National Park today, a protected sanctuary that serves as a vital habitat for over 50 mammal species, 525 bird species, and numerous reptiles. Throughout the day, expert naturalists will guide you through a series of thrilling wildlife activities designed to showcase Nepal's rich biodiversity:

- Canoe Trip & Crocodile Walk: Glide peacefully down the Rapti or Narayani River in a traditional dugout canoe, keeping an eye out for rare Gharial crocodiles and basking mugger crocodiles along the riverbanks.
- Jungle Safari & Wildlife Spotting: Search the subtropical forests and grasslands for endangered species, including the One-horned Rhinoceros, wild elephants, spotted deer, and—with a bit of good fortune—the majestic Royal Bengal Tiger.
- Bird Watching: Spot vibrant avian wildlife, including the Bengal Florican, Giant Hornbill, and various migratory storks.
- Cultural Tharu Dance Evening: Conclude your unforgettable day by gathering around in the evening to watch an energetic Tharu folk dance performance, where local villagers

dressed in traditional colorful costumes celebrate their heritage through music and rhythm.

In the afternoon, you will explore the serene monastic zone and visit the revered Maya Devi Temple, which marks the exact birthplace of Siddhartha Gautama. Walking through this tranquil UNESCO World Heritage Site offers a profound sense of peace and spiritual reflection as you discover ancient pillar inscriptions, sacred ponds, and international monasteries built by Buddhist communities from around the world.

Day 9: Comprehensive Sacred Exploration of Lumbini & Tilaurakot

Continue your deep spiritual journey today by exploring the profound historical and sacred sites of Lumbini. As the birthplace of Lord Buddha, this peaceful sanctuary draws pilgrims and seekers from all over the world.

Accompanied by your guide, you will visit the sacred Maya Devi Temple, which houses the exact ruins and the marker stone identifying the birthplace of Siddhartha Gautama in 623 BC. Nearby, you will observe the holy Puskarni Pond, where Queen Maya Devi took a ritual dip before giving birth, and the historic Ashoka Pillar inscribed with Emperor Ashoka's historical visit.

Your tour also includes an excursion to the nearby ancient kingdom of Kapilvastu (Tilaurakot), where Prince Siddhartha spent his formative early years, as well as a peaceful tour through the international monastic zone to admire the unique architecture of global Buddhist stupas and temples.
