Conclude your cultural journey at Patan Durbar Square, marveling at its exquisite Newari woodcarvings, stone architecture, and ancient royal courtyards.

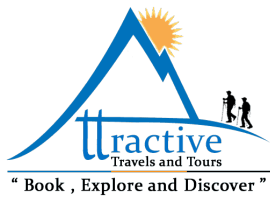
