The Chepang Hill Trek is a newly opened, untouched trekking route in Chitwan, passing through the Chepang Village. This area is 86 km away from Kathmandu. The Chepang Hill Trek offers a unique blend of cultural, sightseeing experience and distinct lifestyle of the Chepang. Dhading and Chitwan Chepang Hills Trekking are sole because of one of the most ethnic Chepang Culture in Nepal. [Chepangs](#) language, leading a roaming life and their lifestyle makes them very different and unique. They go hunting, digging for wild root, fishing and established farming near wildernesses for their livelihood. Their settlements, house construction, social organization, language, customs, festivals, and religion are unique.

The Chepang Hill trek presents you with a liberal satisfaction, as it leads you to the homeland of Chepangs and their remote villages. This generates many income opportunities for native tribe.

Awareness about the Chepang culture among foreigners and the Nepali people is also garnered. A doctrine healer, Praja Pande is an interesting acquaintance that you can choose to make here. Also, you can witness the warm and unique hospitality and their craftsmanship which includes homemade wine and honey. Always they reside in the remote and sparse contours of Dhading, Chitwan, Gorkha and Makawanpur districts. The Dhading/Chitwan Chepang Hills Trekking offers an odd combination of cultural (Hunting Gathering) experience.

The Chepang Hill Trek includes splendid views of the wide range of Himalayan peaks such as Rolwaling, Gauri Shankar, Langtang, Manaslu, Annapurna range, Dhaulagiri and many others. The sunrise view from Sira-Chuli is magnificent along with various ranges of the Himalayas. Bird watching and other natural attractions will make your trekking a memorable experience. You can also tour [Chitwan National Park](#) which is home to an abundance of wild animals and birds in this trek. The park is home to about 600 species of plants, rare One-horned Rhinos and other endangered species like the Royal Bengal Tigers, Dolphins, and Gharial Crocodiles. You can also witness other wild animals such as Tigers, Leopards, Sloth Bears, Wild Boars, Hyenas and many more.
