### **Q: What season is ideal for visiting Chitwan?**

If you can handle the heat, come to Chitwan in April or May at the end of the dry season when wildlife naturally gravitates at waterholes – expect meltingly hot temperatures in the mid 40°C range. However, October to early March is the best time to visit Chitwan for moderate 25°C temps. Most nights in January are below freezing, making it the coldest month.

### **Q: Is it worthwhile to travel to Chitwan?**

Numerous threatened species, including the one-horned rhinoceros, royal Bengal tigers, gharial crocodiles, and freshwater gangetic dolphins, can be found in Chitwan National Park. Additionally, there are four species of deer, two different kinds of monkeys, wild boars, sloth bears, elephants, and leopards, all of which have robust populations.

### **Q: What has Chitwan been renowned for?**

The first national park in Nepal is called Chitwan National Park. It was founded in 2030 B.C. The park encompasses 932 square kilometers and is recognized as a World Heritage site. A conservation area for vultures and gharials, as well as an elephant breeding facility, are among the park's features.

### **Q: Does Chitwan National Park have tigers?**

According to a countrywide census conducted in 2022, Chitwan National Park is home to 128 Royal Bengal Tigers.

### **Q: What is the driving time from Kathmandu to Chitwan?**

Nearly five hours

The travel time by land from Kathmandu to the Chitwan National Park only takes around five hours on a good day. It's a beautiful trip that follows the Trisuli Valley, known for its steep hills covered in forest and farming communities, before heading south and heading toward the plains.
