Understanding the Indigenous Chepang Community

The heart of this trip involves engaging with local residents. They represent one of Nepal's most unique indigenous groups. **Historically**, they lived as semi-nomadic hunter-gatherers. **Therefore**, they share an ancient bond with nature. **Today**, residents practice hillside farming and traditional handicrafts. **By staying** in their village, you gain a rare cultural window. **Moreover**, you actively support community growth and education initiatives during your **Jogimara Chepang Trip**.

Geographical Location of the Chepang Tour

Jogimara sits inside the rugged hills of the Dhading district. **Specifically**, it stretches along the Mahabharat mountain range. Itinerary

Day 1: Scenic Drive from Kathmandu to Jogimara & Village Welcome

Begin your journey with an early morning scenic drive from Kathmandu along the winding Prithvi Highway toward Jogimara (Dhading district). Upon arrival, you will be warmly welcomed by your local host family with traditional greetings. Enjoy a village orientation to get acquainted with the surroundings, settle into your community homestay, and spend the afternoon with a cultural introduction to the indigenous Chepang lifestyle, setting the tone for your immersive stay.

- Location: Kathmandu to Jogimara (Dhading)
- Drive Hours: Approximately 4 to 5 hours by road
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Lunch and Dinner (Breakfast varies by departure time)
- Tour Hours: Approximately 2 to 3 hours (Village orientation and welcome program)

Day 2: School Volunteering & Student Interaction

Dedicate your day to supporting the local school and education development. Work alongside local teachers by engaging students through interactive English conversation classes, reading sessions, creative learning exercises, and educational games. Bring extra energy for sports activities and a meaningful cultural exchange program where you and the students can share stories, songs, and smiles.

- Location: Jogimara Local School
- Drive Hours: None (Walking access within the village)
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)
- Tour Hours: Approximately 5 to 6 hours (School volunteering and structured classroom activities)

Day 3: Community Development & Environmental Project

Participate directly in hands-on community development projects aimed at improving village infrastructure and sustainability. Work hand-in-hand with locals on initiatives such as tree planting, school beautification, community garden maintenance, environmental conservation awareness, or localized village improvement activities.

- Location: Jogimara Village Area
- Drive Hours: None (Local community project site)
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)
- Tour Hours: Approximately 4 to 5 hours (Community development and hands-on project work)

Day 4: Chepang Culture, Farming & Daily Village Life

Dive deep into the unique heritage and daily routines of the Chepang community. Experience traditional hillside farming practices, try your hand at local cooking methods using organic ingredients, and observe or participate in indigenous handicraft-making. This day offers an authentic window into how the community lives closely connected to nature.

- Location: Jogimara Village & Surrounding Farmlands
- Drive Hours: None (Village exploration on foot)
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)
- Tour Hours: Approximately 4 to 5 hours (Cultural immersion, farming, and handicraft sessions)

Day 5: Nature Hike, Local Flora & Viewpoint Exploration

Lace up your walking shoes for a guided nature hike through the surrounding hills, sub-tropical forests, and terraced landscapes. Discover native plants, spot local bird species, and hike up to nearby scenic viewpoints offering gorgeous vistas of the surrounding valleys. Along the way, enjoy casual interactions with local families living in remote hillside homesteads.

- Location: Jogimara Hills and Forest Trails
- Drive Hours: None (Hiking day)
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)

- Tour Hours: Approximately 5 to 6 hours (Guided nature hike and viewpoint exploration)

Day 6: Final School Program & Evening Farewell Celebration

Return to the local school for your final day of teaching, mentoring, and wrap-up activities with the children. In the evening, celebrate your time in the village with a special farewell cultural program. Enjoy traditional Chepang music, rhythmic indigenous dances, and a communal feast featuring regional local cuisine alongside your host family and community members.

- Location: Jogimara Village School & Community Grounds
- Drive Hours: None
- Accommodation: Community Homestay / Local Lodge in Jogimara
- Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)
- Tour Hours: Morning school session and evening cultural farewell program (approx. 5 hours total)

Day 7: Farewell to Host Family & Return to Kathmandu

Wake up to a peaceful village morning and enjoy a hearty breakfast with your host family. Gather for a heartfelt final goodbye, bid farewell to your hosts, and board your transport for the scenic return drive back to Kathmandu, carrying unforgettable memories, shared stories, and lifelong friendships.

- Location: Jogimara to Kathmandu
- Drive Hours: Approximately 4 to 5 hours by road
